Law Office Sepers



***Certain procedures are required to be performed
particularly by capital stock companies during***

***the transition from the Law numbered to 6762 to
the Law numbered 6102.***

1. Real/legal persons who are the sole
partners/shareholders of joint stock companies and
limited companies shall notify the board of
directors/director through the notary public within a
period of 15 days following the date on which the
law has become effective (01.07.2012) who in turn
shall register this fact within a period of 7 days
(Article 23 of the Law numbered 6103).

2. Partners of joint stock companies and
limited companies are obliged to pay all their debts
to the company in cash within a period of three
years following the date on which the law has
become effective (Article 24 of the Law numbered
6103) (before 01.07.2015). Otherwise creditors of
the company will be entitled to collect their
receivables from the company through legal
proceedings to be initiated against the partner who
is indebted to the company. In addition any partner
who has not paid all his/her debts to the company
shall be subjected to a judicial fine not less than 300
days (Article 562 of the Turkish Commercial Code).

3. Members of the board of directors of joint
stock companies and directors of limited companies
holding a seat as of the date on which the Turkish
Commercial Code has become effective shall
continue their duties until the expiry of their term of
office save for any discharge or quittance. However
those who were elected in representation of a legal
person shall resign within a period of three months
following the date on which the law has become
effective (before 01.10.2012) and the legal person
or other persons shall be elected as their
replacement. Appointment of new members to the
seats that are evacuated due to discharge,
quittance or resignation of the legal person shall be
made in accordance with the new Law. In limited
Companies where all partners act as administrators
and representatives in their capacity as directors,
new directors shall be designated within a period of
three months following publication of the Law
(Article 25 of the Law numbered 6103, article 623 of
the Turkish Commercial Code).

4. If the articles of association of joint stock
companies or limited companies state that the Law
numbered 6762 shall apply with respect to the
meeting/resolution quorums of the general
shareholders' meetings/ board of directors'
meetings or if any reference is made to the Law
numbered 6762 to that respect, such companies are
obliged to render their articles of association
compliant with the new Turkish Commercial Code
within a period of 6 months following the date on

which the new Turkish Commercial Law has become effective (before 01.01.2013). The quorums stipulated in the Law numbered 6762 shall apply for the general shareholders' meetings convened for that purpose. Provisions of the new Turkish Commercial Code shall be applied *sua sponte* in case of failure to make an amendment within a period of 6 months. However if the articles of association of these companies which are currently in force stipulate aggravated quorums which are stricter than the quorums stipulated in article 421 of the new Turkish Commercial Code the companies may continue to apply such quorums.

5. If special auditors who were appointed before the effective date of the Law have not submitted their reports yet, they shall prepare these reports in accordance with the new Turkish Commercial Code. However these auditors may resign from office without being subject to any indemnity/sanction (Article 27 of the Law numbered 6103).

6. Capital stock companies are obliged to provide a website or if the company already has a website, to allocate a section of this website to the matters stipulated in the new Turkish Commercial Code. Article 1524 of the Turkish Commercial Code will be effective as of 1.7.2013.

Turkish Market-in Brief

Over the past few years the Turkish economy has been expanding and developing rapidly. For many years the Turkish economic development has been severely affected by both domestic and international factors. However in 2003, shortly after one of the

largest financial crises of the Turkish Republic's history, the country took several steps towards liberalizing its economy and integrating into the global economy. Since the financial crises broke out in the Eurozone, financial institutions in Turkey have managed to remain healthy and profitable unlike many financial institutions in the Eurozone and other parts of the world. Although the recent financial crisis affected Turkey for a time in 2009, its effects have been limited and temporary. In the meantime the country has taken several steps and met majority of the criteria set by the European Union for it to become a member.

During this process the country also suffered a number of political, economic, geographic and social problems. Alongside the global financial crisis, Arab Spring can be named as the second important factor that really concerns the Turkish economic development. But despite all these negative incidents Turkey is among the most interesting addresses for foreign direct investment. The recent economic indicators once again confirmed Turkey's booming economy and candidacy to become one of the largest economies and regional powers in the 21st century. With The New Turkish Commercial Code that will come into force in 2012 the country will be taking another step forward towards a more competitive, fairer, more transparent and stronger economy. The New Turkish Commercial Code also can be regarded as the country's powerful commitment to equilibrate with the developed nations.

Although Turkey's credit rating has been downgraded very recently by the international crediting agencies due to economic risks originating from the global economy, the country's promising economy, stabilized political conditions and resources prove that the country will overcome these difficulties. In 2011, in the first 3 quarters, the Turkish economy recorded very high growth rates with an average of %9,6. Recent indicators also show that the unemployment rate in the country decreased to its lowest level in the past 10 years. Turkey's modern, sensible and cooperative political and economic approach puts the country on the list of most interesting countries in which to be and to do business.

Top private companies rewarded at ceremony

Leading Turkish companies who topped the Capital 500 list, an annual event organized by the local publication Capital magazine, received their prizes at a ceremony held on the evening of Dec. 13 in Istanbul.

Energy, consumption and service companies dominated the list that evaluated performance of 2010, with petrochemical company Tüpraş ranking first. It is the second year in a row it has taken the award. Its 2010 revenues hit 26.2 billion Turkish Liras, a 29 percent jump from 2009.

Kale receives award
İbrahim Bodur, honorary president of the Kale Group active in several businesses including ceramics, chemicals and defense, was also recognized during the event sponsored by Vodafone, the second biggest mobile phone operator in Turkey.

Aydın Doğan, the honorary chairman of Doğan Holding, presented the award to CEO of the executive Kale Group Zeynep Bodur Okyay as her father could not attend the evening due to health problems.
Five energy firms, along with seven consumption and service firms, ranked among the top 20 biggest revenue-making companies in 2010.

OMV Petrol Ofisi, the Turkey unit of the Austrian

energy giant, posted 16.1 billion liras in revenues last year, according to the Capital 500 list.

Türk Telekom, the country's biggest land phone operator, ranked third, reaching 10.8 billion liras, while Opet, another oil retailer, followed with 10.5 billion liras in revenue. Shell & Turcas Petrol ranked as the sixth biggest revenue maker with 9.3 billion liras. Turkcell, Turkey's leading GSM company, reported 9 billion liras.

No plans to sell assets
Meanwhile, Doğan Holding has no plans to sell any media assets, according to its honorary chairman. "We have had no such idea of selling any of our media assets, including Kanal D, Hürriyet, Posta or CNN

Türk," Doğan said, talking to journalists on the sidelines of the Capital 500 ceremony.

Doğan said he wished success to the media companies the group had earlier departed from.

Vorig jaar beten 11 ondernemers met hun mentoren de spits af. Tijdens het evenement ontving DtHaD niet alleen de nieuwe ondernemers met hun coaches, maar namen we ook afscheid van deze eerste groep. Overigens niet nadat een vakjury een winnend koppel uit deze groep had aangewezen en de Dutch Dream Award had uitgereikt.
Inspirerende prominenten uit de politiek en het bedrijfsleven spraken deze dag spreken.
Over Dutch Dream Foundation
Dutch Dream Foundation werd in 2006 opgericht naar aanleiding van *Atila's Dutch Dream*, het boek dat Atila Aytekin schreef. Aytekin, een Turks-Nederlandse ondernemer en CEO van Triodor Software International, beschrijft in deze

autobiografie hoe het is om als bi-culturele entrepreneur tegen de stroom in te moeten zwemmen. Aytekin richtte Dutch Dream Foundation op om het Nederlandse ondernemersklimaat te ondersteunen.

Over Dare to have a Dream

Veel ondernemers belanden na het opzetten van een eigen bedrijf in een fase waarin ze een extra duw en inspiratie kunnen gebruiken om door te groeien. Voor hen zijn de CEO's en directeurs van toponderningen weliswaar een rolmodel, maar tussen beide werelden ligt gevoelsmatig een enorme kloof. Het project *Dare to have a Dream* overbrugt deze kloof door veelbelovende jonge ondernemers en CEO's en directeurs van toponderningen samen te brengen. De ondernemers worden een jaar lang, één op één gecoacht door een topmanager, ceo of directeur. De jonge ondernemers doen op deze manier niet alleen inspiratie, kennis en waardevolle contacten op, maar worden ook actief door hun coach geadviseerd en begeleid in het oplossen van problemen waar ze tegenaan lopen.
